We are welcoming and friendly places where you can find lots of advice, support and guidance for you and your children, and have the chance to meet up with other local families in your area.

You will find us across local communities in Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole. We are open to everyone, providing help and guidance for every parent, carer or grandparent. In fact, any families who need support, advice, or just time to check in with other people and professionals, in a safe space.

Getting help and support at the earliest possible time can make all the difference, both for you, your child or young person. It can prevent bigger problems later in life, and often small changes and support can make such a difference.

We have lots of partners involved with the family hubs. That means we team up with all sorts of organisations and groups to make sure you get what you need from one place.

You only need to ask for help once, and we'll make sure you get to the right person, with the right support for you.

Together with our partners, we can offer support and advice in the following areas:
