Learning a language can be lots of fun and there is lots of help out there to support your child's learning of a foreign language. There are various apps and websites available online to help and support pupils with their Spanish language learning. The following is a brief selection. Please note that there may be a small cost to download some of them. Disfrutas!



The **Spanish Builder** app supports the scheme of work that we use in school. Lots of opportunities to practise, using games and songs, enabling children to consolidate their knowledge of phonics, grammar and vocabulary. The children enjoy using it in school.



The award- winning games app, **Pili Pop Espanol**, encourages children to develop their speaking and pronunciation skills. Pili is a virtual animal who is fed regularly by the child practicing using the app. The app is updated regularly.



Bilingual Child uses animated books to teach young learners how to speak Spanish and English. The two characters bring both languages to life.



Spanish School Bus (also called Learn Spanish for Kids) focusses on teaching 300 common words over 60 levels completed through various games. Children earn certificates as they go.



Duolingo is available both as an app and online and is also completely free! It is ideal for complete beginners and for those of us who are a bit rusty since you complete a small test at the start. You are then able to complete levels using all 4 skills- speaking, listening, reading and writing. Grammar and vocabulary are continuously revisited to consolidate learning.
