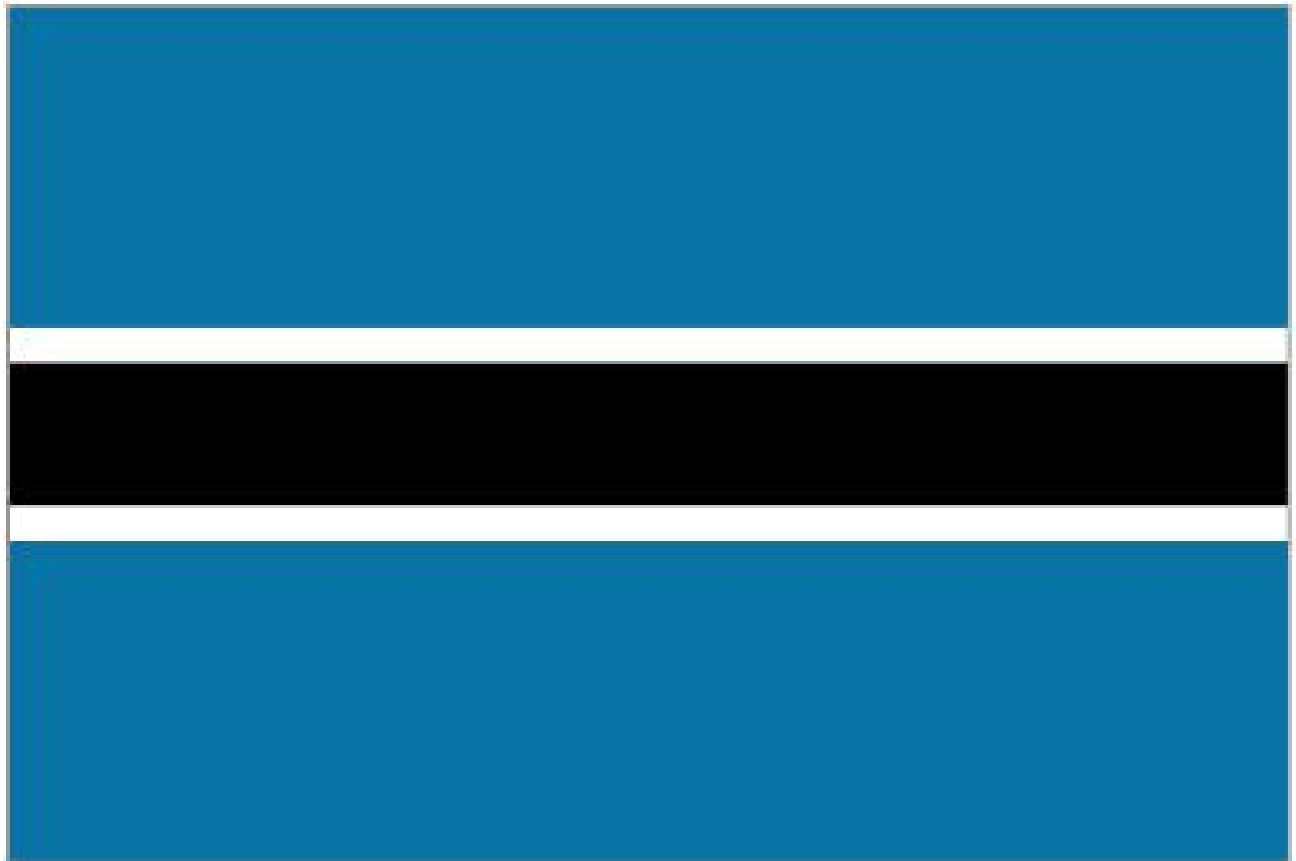
Food

Flag

The flag of Botswana has an important meaning. The top blue represents the sky and the bottom plays the part of the ocean. The black and white stripes symbolize the people. Together they sum up black and white communities living under one sky.



Location
